AND: No birds.

Div: FMN had a guiding for 2 people. FMN and ERD went birdwatching in södra hunden and saw a bat flying around in daylight which was cool! ELL, ALD and JMS went up the lighthouse since ELL is leaving tomorrow and hasn't been up there yet. JMS, VIV, KWL and HXF did plover survey and counted 39 ringed plovers along fyrvägen, 5 of which were colour-ringed. MHM and co. found a Glaucous gull on the cape which FMN and JSA were lucky to see. We activated the new funnel trap with white wagtail playback since there have been many in the area. We couldn't manage to trap any wagtails but a linnnet found its way inside and marked the first bird ringed using this new trap! In the afternoon JSA noticed a pair of grey partridges in krattet and trapped them. Later in the evening JSA went nightcatching and caught a nice adult cormorant!
