It was in Swedish but that didn't stop some of us non-swedish speaking staff members to attend. HXF held a presentation in the library explaining her project about bird conservation that has taken her to many cool places in Europe and Asia over the past year. The SVT channel came to interview MHM in the morning. JVJ started his work on the spring surveys, with taking pictures of the water level in preparation for the european green toad census. MHM saw the lesser scaup just south of the wall that delineates the Ottenby area, meaning it is now species 400 for Ottenby!
